## Management Discussion of Fund Performance

June 3, 2019

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments during the period ended March 31, 2019, that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook. If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period from inception to the end of the fiscal period. For information on the Fund's longer-term performance, as applicable, please refer to the *Past Performance* section of the report. In this report, "Mackenzie" refers to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

### Investment Objective and Strategies

The Fund seeks above-average income with potential for long-term capital growth by investing primarily in higher-yielding Canadian fixed income securities and equities. It may hold up to 49% of its assets in foreign investments.

### Risk

The risks of the Fund remain as discussed in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus.

The Fund is suitable for short- to medium-term investors looking for a Canadian fixed income fund to hold as part of their portfolio, who can handle the volatility of bond markets and who have a low to medium tolerance for risk.

### Results of Operations

#### Investment Performance

The performance of the Fund's Series A and Series LB securities is discussed below. The performance of all series is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Where series returns differ, it is primarily because different levels of fees and expenses were charged to each series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series.

During the year, the Fund's Series A securities returned 2.5%, and Series LB securities returned 2.4% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with a return of 5.3% for the Fund's broad-based index, the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index, and a return of 5.0% for a blended index composed of a 50% weighting in the ICE BofAML High Yield Canadian Issuers (Hedged) Index (returned 5.3%) and a 50% weighting in the ICE BofAML US High Yield (Hedged) Index (returned 4.8%). All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in an index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

The Canadian bond market outperformed the broader global bond market during the year. The Canadian yield curve flattened as yields on shorter-term bonds rose significantly while mid- and longer-term yields fell. High-yield credit spreads (the difference in yield between investment grade and high-yield bonds of similar maturities) widened slightly over the year. Although the U.S. economy was generally strong, global trade tensions and the impact of higher policy rates led investors to fear slower growth. As a result, high-yield bonds fell. A more moderate tone from the U.S. Federal Reserve late in the year helped revive prices for risk assets.

The Fund underperformed the broad-based index because of its exposure to U.S. high-yield bonds, which underperformed the broader market. Given the Fund's mandate, the return of the blended index is a more meaningful comparison.

The Fund underperformed the blended index, with security selection among energy bonds, as well as underweight positions in consumer goods and in technology and electronics, detracting from performance.

Conversely, overweight positions in telecommunications, leisure and healthcare bonds contributed to performance.

The Fund hedged its foreign currency exposure, which detracted from absolute performance primarily as the U.S. dollar appreciated relative to the Canadian dollar.

Over the year, portfolio activity and market effect resulted in increased exposure to Canada, while exposure to the United States decreased.

### Net Assets

The Fund's NAV declined by 38.3% to \$503.9 million at March 31, 2019, from \$816.7 million at March 31, 2018. This change was composed primarily of \$18.3 million in net income (including dividend and interest income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, \$320.9 million in net redemptions, and \$10.1 million in cash distributions. The net redemptions included outflows of \$174.0 million relating to redemptions by mutual funds managed by Mackenzie. These redemptions were managed without any adverse effect on the Fund.

### Fees and Expenses

The management expense ratios ("MERs") for Series A of 1.70% and for Series LB of 1.77% during the year ended March 31, 2019, were unchanged from the MERs for the year ended March 31, 2018. The MERs (before and after waivers or absorptions, if any) for all series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report. The MER for Series F decreased due to a decrease in the management fee rate effective June 1, 2018, as noted in the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of the report.

### Recent Developments

The portfolio management team has a positive outlook on high-yield markets. In the United States, economic data and company earnings remain supportive of high-yield issuers, and default levels remain low. In Canada, the team believes stabilizing oil prices should benefit the large percentage of commodity-sensitive issuers.

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The team is neutral on valuations. High-yield credit spreads tightened significantly in the first three months of calendar 2019, after widening substantially in the final three months of 2018. However, the team believes spreads remain fair given solid fundamentals.

The team also has a neutral outlook on market technical factors. In the team's view, strong demand for yield, low levels of net new issuance, and strong inflows into the asset class at the start of 2019 have created a favourable backdrop.

Effective June 1, 2018, Series E and Series PWF securities were consolidated into Series F securities.

## Related Party Transactions

The following arrangements result in fees paid by the Fund to Mackenzie or to companies affiliated with the Fund.

## Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to Mackenzie at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, Mackenzie pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

## Other Related Party Transactions

Investment funds managed by Mackenzie invest in Series R securities of the Fund on a prospectus-exempt basis in accordance with the investment objectives of those funds. Series S securities are also offered on a prospectus-exempt basis to London Life Insurance Company, The Great-West Life Assurance Company and The Canada Life Assurance Company (collectively, the "Related Insurance Companies"), all of which are companies affiliated with Mackenzie. At March 31, 2019, funds managed by Mackenzie owned 0.4% of the Fund's NAV, and the Related Insurance Companies owned 3.8% of the Fund's NAV. All related party transactions are based on the NAV per security on each transaction day.

At March 31, 2019, Mackenzie had an investment of \$6,409 in the Fund (less than 0.1% of the Fund's NAV).

Mackenzie relied on a recommendation issued by the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee to allow top funds managed by Mackenzie to redeem their investments in the Fund in March 2019.

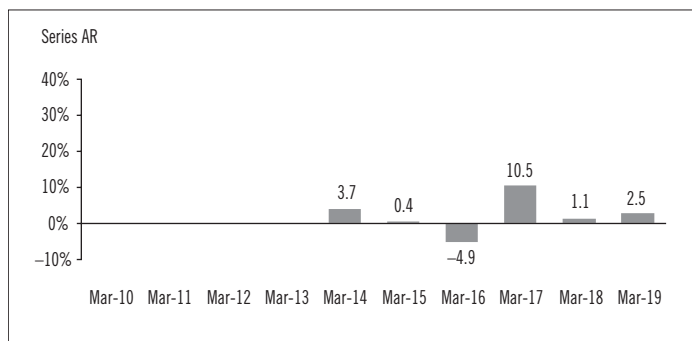
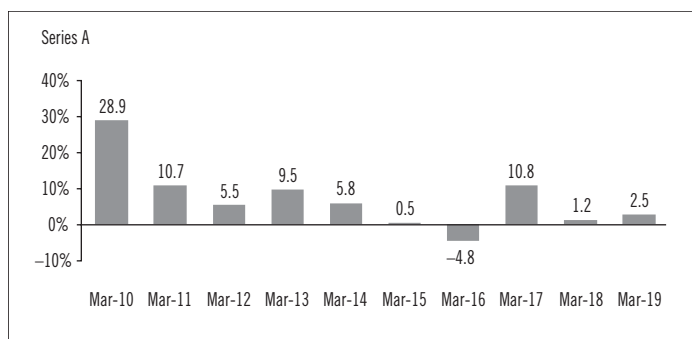
## Past Performance

The blended index is composed of 50% ICE BofAML High Yield Canadian Issuers (Hedged) Index and 50% ICE BofAML U.S. High Yield (Hedged) Index.

The FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index is a broad measure of Canadian bonds with terms to maturity of more than one year. It includes federal, provincial, municipal and corporate bonds rated "BBB" or higher.

The ICE BofAML High Yield Canadian Issuers (Hedged) Index tracks the performance of non-investment grade debt publicly issued by Canadian issuers. Qualifying bonds must have at least one year remaining term to maturity, a fixed coupon schedule and a minimum amount outstanding of C\$100 million. The foreign currency exposure is hedged back to the Canadian dollar.

The ICE BofAML U.S. High Yield (Hedged) Index tracks the performance of non-investment grade U.S. dollar-denominated corporate bonds publicly issued in the U.S. domestic market. Qualifying bonds must have at least one year remaining term to maturity, a fixed coupon schedule and a minimum amount outstanding of US\$100 million. The foreign currency exposure is hedged back to the Canadian dollar.

## Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by Mackenzie in part to pay Putnam Advisory Company LLC, an affiliate of Mackenzie, for investment advisory services, including managing the investment portfolio, providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions and making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio. Mackenzie also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

LBC Financial Services Inc. ("LBC") is the principal distributor for the LBC series securities of the Fund (as listed under *Fund Formation and Series Information*) and receives a portion of the management fees that the Fund pays to Mackenzie. Under this arrangement, LBC was entitled to approximately 23% of the total management fees that Mackenzie received from the LBC series of all Mackenzie funds during the year. Mackenzie is responsible for paying all distribution-related payments to LBC-authorized dealers whose clients invest in the LBC series of the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with Mackenzie may be entitled to distribution-related payments from Mackenzie on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: IPC Securities Corporation, Investors Group Securities Inc., IPC Investment Corporation and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

Mackenzie used approximately 43% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the year to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 31% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the year. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series.

Series F securities are offered to investors who are enrolled in a dealer-sponsored fee-for-service or wrap program, who are subject to an asset-based fee rather than commissions on each transaction and who invest at least \$500; they are also available to employees of Mackenzie and its subsidiaries, and directors of Mackenzie.

Series FB securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor.

Series I securities are offered to retail investors investing a minimum of \$500 in a qualified group plan with a minimum of \$20,000,000 in assets.

Series O securities are offered only to investors investing a minimum of \$500,000 who are enrolled in Mackenzie Portfolio Architecture Service or Open Architecture Service; certain institutional investors; and certain qualifying employees of Mackenzie and its subsidiaries.

Series PW securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000.

Series PWFB securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor.

Series PWR securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000 in a Registered Disability Savings Plan offered by Mackenzie.

Series PWX securities are offered through our Private Wealth Solutions to certain high net worth investors who invest a minimum of \$100,000. Investors are required to negotiate their advisor service fee, which cannot exceed 1.50%, with their financial advisor.

Series R securities are offered only to other affiliated funds and certain institutional investors in connection with fund-of-fund arrangements.

Series S securities are offered to the Related Insurance Companies and certain other mutual funds, but may be sold to other investors as determined by Mackenzie.

Series E and Series PWF securities are no longer available for sale. Effective June 1, 2018, Series E and Series PWF securities were consolidated into Series F securities.

Series G securities are no longer available for sale, except for additional purchases by investors who have held these securities since December 11, 2017.

Series J, Series PWT8 and Series PWX8 securities are no longer available for sale.
